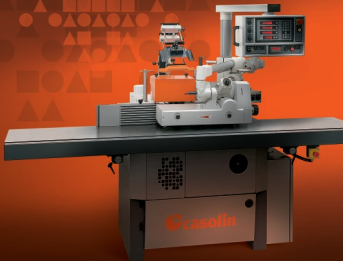

Abstract The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of a 12-week training program on the physical fitness and health-related quality of life (HRQL) of sedentary, middle-aged women. The study was a randomized, controlled trial. The intervention group (IG) participated in a 12-week training program, while the control group (CG) remained sedentary. The IG showed significant improvements in physical fitness and HRQL compared to the CG. The study was a randomized controlled trial. The intervention group (n = 20) participated in a 12-week, low-intensity, supervised exercise program. The control group (n = 20) did not participate in the exercise program. The primary outcome was the change in the Mini-Mental State Examination (MMSE) score. The secondary outcomes were the change in the Beck Depression Inventory (BDI) score, the change in the Physical Functioning (PF) score, and the change in the Quality of Life (QoL) score. The results showed that the intervention group had a significantly greater improvement in the MMSE score, the BDI score, the PF score, and the QoL score compared to the control group. The findings suggest that a 12-week, low-intensity, supervised exercise program can improve the physical and psychological health of older adults with MCI.
